Attention air carriers planning ad hoc flights to Göteborg Landvetter Airport 13-17 November 2017

Subject: EU Summit in Gothenburg

To whom it may concern,

Together with President of the European Commission Jean-Claude Juncker, Sweden's Prime Minister Stefan Löfven will host a Social Summit in Gothenburg on 17 November 2017. This will lead to an additional demand at Göteborg Landvetter Airport since delegations from EU countries are expected to arrive mainly with state aircrafts.

For the period of **13th November 0700 UTC to 17th November 2300 UTC** restrictions will apply in order to handle a high volume of state traffic while maintaining the ordinary timetable traffic at the airport in an efficient and punctual manner.

Following restrictions apply for the period:

- No ad hoc-flights are allowed at Göteborg Landvetter from 14th November 1100 UTC until 17th November 2300 UTC except for airlines with own leased areas in the Demarcated Area (DMA). No aircrafts in addition to ordinary timetable traffic are allowed to park at the airport during this period.
- During the period 13th November 0700 UTC to 14th November 1100 UTC ad hoc flights with a turnaround time of maximum 120 minutes will be allowed.

The following flights are exempted from slot allocation but we highly recommend that the operators keep us informed of their intention even on short notice:

- Medical, emergencies, evacuation or humanitarian flights
- State and military flights
- Search and rescue operations
- Emergency operations

In addition, an AIP supplement will be published with subsequent NOTAM before the event.

Operators who already have got slots cleared for the period will not be affected.
